
1. TEAR AND GLUE



Students will tear pieces of paper and glue them on the picture.

6 Picture Options:
Apple, applesauce,
apple blossom, caramel
apple, apple cider,
apple tree

2. CUT AND GLUE



Students will cut 1-inch strips and glue the seeds on the apple.

3. MAKE A PUZZLE



Students will color, cut out, and glue the puzzle.

5 Puzzle Options:
Apple with a worm,
apple, apple pie,
apple jam, apple
blossoms


4. POKE A PIN



Students will use a jumbo push pin to carefully poke the holes.

<u>5 Picture Options:</u> Apple, worm, tree, apple pie, applesauce


5. HOLE PUNCHING



Students will punch apples to match the number on each card.

Includes numbers 1-12.


6. LINKING CARDS



Students will use plastic links to link the tree to the matching apple.


Includes 9 sets of linking cards.

7. BEAD COUNTING AND SORTING



You can select the counting cards or the color sorting cards.

Students will string beads onto the pipe cleaner to either show the number (top photo) or match the colors (bottom photo).



8. FORMATION CARDS

There are five sets of cards.



Prewriting lines (great for sand tracing!)



Uppercase alphabet



Lowercase alphabet



Numbers 1-10



Shapes (14 cards)

9. STICKER PICTURES



Students will use small stickers to outline the picture.

5 Picture Options:
Apple, applesauce,
caramel apple, worm,
apple pie

10. TWEEZING

There are two options: color sorting (11 cards) or counting (numbers 1-20).






11. DOUGH MATS



Students will use playdough to form apples in different colors.

There are 10 halfpage sized cards and 10 quarter-page sized cards.

12. CLOTHESPINS



Students will count the apples in each basket and clip the correct number.

Cards are included for numbers 0-10.


13. COVER UP MATS



Students will use small objects to cover the dots on each apple. You could use buttons, mini erasers, or any other small object.

You can easily turn this into a gluing practice activity!

14. LINE TRACING



Students will use a dryerase marker to trace the lines from top to bottom.

Includes 21 cards.
