In this book, students will glue a picture onto the recycling bin on each page (except for the last page). The sets of pictures print five-to-a-page and each student needs one set.

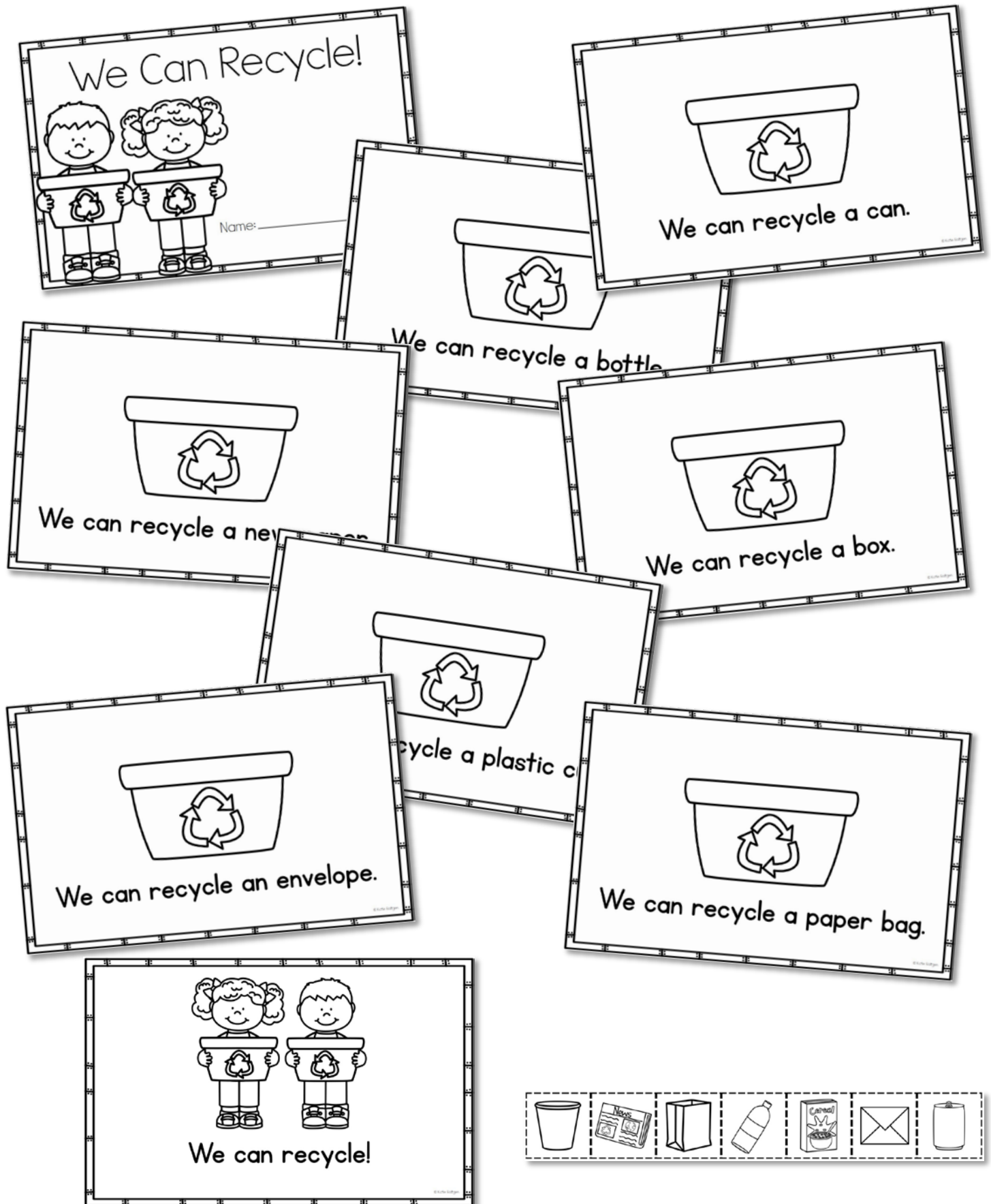
Book Two: I Help the Earth

Book Three: Earth Day

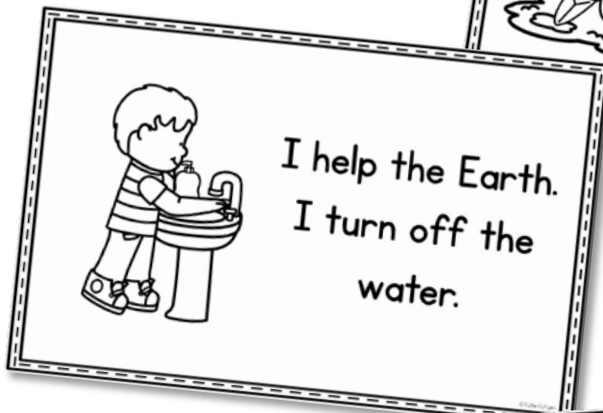
This book is slightly more difficult but still provides strong picture support.
