Most of the activities include black-andwhite options. Some activities, such as the color sorting bead activity, do not have a black-and-white option due to the nature of the activities.




1. TEAR AND GLUE



Students will tear pieces of paper and glue them on the picture.


5 Picture Options: Ghost, candy corn, cauldron, pumpkin, candy

2. CUT AND GLUE



Students will cut 1-inch strips and glue the candy on the candy bag.


3. MAKE A PUZZLE



Students will color, cut out, and glue the puzzle.

5 Puzzle Options: Cauldron, bat, owl with candy corn, ghosts, candy corn


4. POKE A PIN



Students will use a jumbo push pin to carefully poke the holes.

5 Picture Options: Candy, candy corn, ghost, cauldron, pumpkin


5. HOLE PUNCHING



Students will punch candies to match the number on each card.

Includes numbers 1-12.

6. LINKING CARDS



Students will count the candy and use plastic links to link the candy card to the correct number.

Includes 11 pairs of linking cards.

7. SORTING BEADS BY COLOR



Students will string beads onto the pipe cleaner to match the colors.

8. FORMATION CARDS

There are five sets of cards.



Prewriting lines (great for sand tracing!)



Uppercase alphabet



Lowercase alphabet




Numbers 1-10



Shapes (14 cards)

9. STICKER PICTURES



Students will use small stickers to outline the picture.

5 Picture Options: Candy corn, spider web, cauldron, spider, mask

10. TWEEZING



Students will use tweezers to sort pompom balls by color.

11. DOUGH MATS



Students will use playdough to form spiders in different colors.

There are 10 halfpage sized cards and 10 quarter-page sized cards.

12. CLOTHESPINS



Students will count the ghosts and clip the correct number.

Cards are included for numbers 0-10.


13. COVER UP MATS



Students will use small objects to cover the dots on each picture. You could use buttons, mini erasers, or any other small object.

You can easily turn this into a gluing practice activity!

14. LINE TRACING



Students will use a dryerase marker to trace the lines from left to right.

Includes 21 cards.
