### **About this Resource:**

This is a set of 20 activities designed to be used in Kindergarten morning work tubs. The activities incorporate common Kindergarten skills in the areas of literacy, math, fine motor, and more. They require supplies that many teachers can find in their classrooms, such as math manipulatives, magnetic letters, and playdough.

#### A few things...

- 1. You may want to change up the activities from what I have suggested or omit certain ones, and that's fine! I designed this resource to provide some activities that teachers could use to save planning and prep time, but it does not have to be used exclusively. You may want to add additional activities based on your own ideas or your students' needs and interests. Or, if you need more than 20 tubs and don't want to duplicate any of these activities, you will have to make your own additional tubs. I have provided a list of additional morning work tub ideas.
- Some of the activities can be customized or changed based on what you have in your classroom.

### **About this Resource:**

 I am including an information page for each activity. In the instructions, it says to place the activities into a container. You can use whatever works in your classroom.

#### Ideas:

- Place activities in plastic tubs and keep them in a tub organizer.
- Place activities into plastic bags and rotate them around your students' tables each day.
- You can make multiple copies of an activity and have all of the students at a table do the same activity.
- 4. I highly recommend laminating all of the pieces, not just the ones that require dry-erase marker or playdough use. It helps them last longer. I also recommend printing on cardstock.
