Materials Needed:

Construction paper Glue sticks Student scissors Crayons Jumbo push pins Single hole punch Plastic links Pipe cleaners Plastic pony beads Sand tray Mini erasers Small stickers Pom-pom balls Tweezers, Tongs, or Scoops Playdough Colorful mini clothespins Dot stickers Buttons or other small objects Dry-erase markers Five 1-inch binder rings (optional) Printer paper and cardstock Laminator and laminating pouches

1. TEAR AND GLUE



Students will tear pieces of paper and glue them on the picture.

6 Picture Options:
Turkey, corn, acorn,
wheat, turkey egg,
feather

2. CUT AND GLUE



Students will out shapes to form a turkey.

3. MAKE A PUZZLE



Students will color, cut out, and glue the puzzle.

5 Puzzle Options:
Turkey, turkey food,
turkey with a book, 1-5
puzzle, turkey with a
pumpkin


4. POKE A PIN



Students will use a jumbo push pin to carefully poke the holes.

5 Picture Options: Corn, two turkeys, acorn, wheat

5. HOLE PUNCHING



Students will punch pieces of corn to match the number on each card.

Includes numbers 1-20.

6. LINKING CARDS



Students will count the feathers on each turkey and use plastic links to link each card to the correct number.

Includes 10 pairs of linking cards.

7. SORTING BEADS BY COLOR



Students will string beads onto the pipe cleaner to match the colors.

8. FORMATION CARDS

There are five sets of cards.



Prewriting lines (great for sand tracing!)



Uppercase alphabet



Lowercase alphabet




Numbers 1-10



Shapes (14 cards)

9. STICKER PICTURES



Students will use small stickers to outline the picture.

<u>6 Picture Options:</u>
Turkey, corn, acorn,
wheat, turkey egg,
feather

10. TWEEZING



Students will use tweezers to sort pompom balls by color.

11. DOUGH MATS



Students will use playdough to form turkey feathers in different colors.

There are 10 halfpage sized cards and 10 quarter-page sized cards.

12. CLOTHESPINS



Students will clip colorful mini clothespins to make feathers on each turkey.

There are 11 different colored turkeys.

13. COVER UP MATS



Students will use small objects to cover the dots on each picture. You could use buttons, mini erasers, or any other small object.

You can easily turn this into a gluing practice activity!

14. LINE TRACING



Students will use a dryerase marker to trace the lines from top to bottom.

Includes 24 cards.
