





FINE MOTOR PUMPKINS

Some of the activities are printables and others require some preparation, such as cutting and laminating.


The activities are easy to adapt to your students' skills and your classroom needs.

Most of the activities include black-and-white options. Some activities, such as the color sorting bead activity, do not have a black-and-white option due to the nature of the activities.




1. TEAR AND GLUE



Students will tear pieces of paper and glue them on the picture.


5 Picture Options:
2 pumpkins, pumpkin pie, pumpkin donut, pumpkin seeds

2. CUT AND GLUE



Students will cut 1-inch strips and glue the seeds on the pumpkin.


3. MAKE A PUZZLE



Students will color, cut out, and glue the puzzle.

5 Puzzle Options:
Pumpkin, pumpkin drink, owl with a pumpkin, pumpkin pie, pumpkin and pencil


4. POKE A PIN



Students will use a jumbo push pin to carefully poke the holes.

5 Picture Options:
Pumpkin seed, pumpkin, pumpkin pie, pumpkin drink, pumpkin donut


5. HOLE PUNCHING



Students will punch pumpkins to match the number on each card.

Includes numbers 1-12.

6. LINKING CARDS



Students will count the pumpkin seeds and use plastic links to link the pumpkin to the correct number.

Includes 11 pairs of linking cards.


7. SORTING BEADS BY COLOR



Students will string beads onto the pipe cleaner to match the colors.

8. FORMATION CARDS

There are five sets of cards.



Prewriting lines (great for sand tracing!)



Uppercase alphabet



Lowercase alphabet




Numbers 1-10

9. STICKER PICTURES




Students will use small stickers to outline the picture.

5 Picture Options:
2 pumpkins, pumpkin pie, pumpkin donut, pumpkin seeds, pumpkin drink

10. TWEEZING

There are two options: color sorting (11 cards) or shape formation (8 cards).




11. DOUGH MATS



Students will use playdough to form pumpkins in different colors.

There are 10 half-page sized cards and 10 quarter-page sized cards.

12. CLOTHESPINS



Students will count the pumpkins and clip the correct number.

Cards are included for numbers 0-10.


13. COVER UP MATS



Students will use small objects to cover the dots on each picture. You could use buttons, mini erasers, or any other small object.

You can easily turn this into a gluing practice activity!

14. LINE TRACING



Students will use a dry-erase marker to trace the lines from left to right.

Includes 21 cards.
