## **ABOUT THIS RESOURCE**

This resource includes four versions of the same book: One written for "Mom", one written for "Aunt", one written for "Grandma", and one addressed to "You", which can be created for any special person in that student's life. Choose the version that is appropriate for each of your students' individual needs!

<u>Preparation:</u> Print the version(s) of the book that you need. Copy collated and stapled in the upper left-hand corner. If you desire, you could copy the front cover onto colored paper.

How to Use: I've found that it works best to begin working on this book as a whole group, and then let students work independently. I sit at my back table and have students come see me when they're done with a page so I can conference with them and read the next page's prompt. If you have students who struggle with writing or working independently, have them sit at the table with you.




## PROMPTS AND OTHER INFO

- 8. The student will draw flowers for his/her mom/aunt/grandma/special person.


