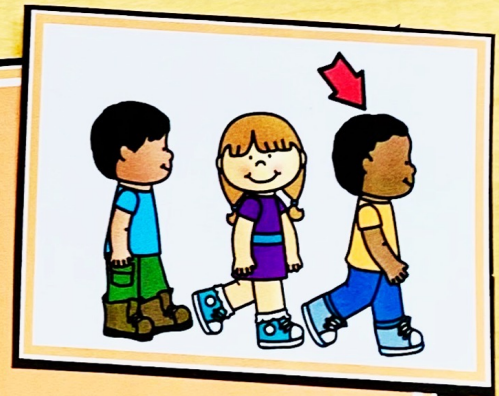

ABOUT THIS RESOURCE:

This pack includes 30 Read and Match cards. Each card has a decodable sentence that focuses on Short E CVC words. Students will read the sentence and find the picture that best matches the sentence.

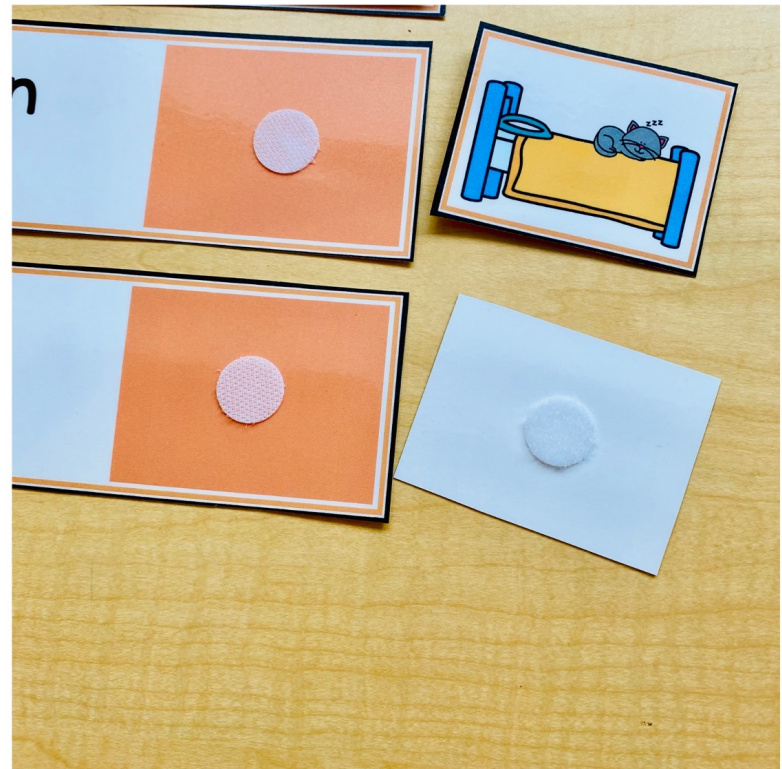
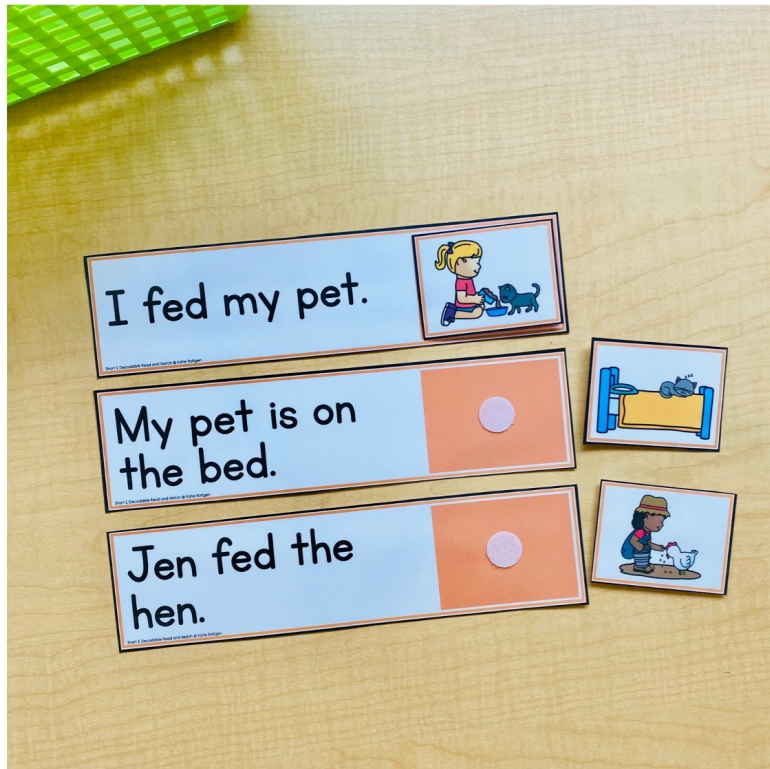

Organization tip: The Short E cards have orange borders and boxes to help keep them separated from the other short vowel card packs.

PREPARATION:

Print the activity on cardstock. Laminate for durability. Cut out the sentence and picture cards.

Optional: Place sticky-back dots (such as Velcro®) on the sentence and picture cards as shown below.



TEACHING IDEAS:

These cards can easily be used in small group instruction or in learning centers. Here's what that might look like in your classroom:

Small group instruction: Give each student a sentence card and present the matching picture cards for those sentences. Each student will read the sentence on their card and pick the correct sentence. Have them read their sentence aloud to check.

Learning centers: Pick sentences that have words your students know. Place the sentence and picture cards in a learning center.

Please read:

There is a good chance you won't use all 30 cards at once. If you're using these as an instructional tool, choose only the sentences and pictures that have high-frequency words and patterns that align with your lesson. For independent work, choose sentences that reinforce HFWs/patterns your students have already learned and practiced with teacher help.
