## Materials Needed:

File folders
Sticker paper or printer paper Cardstock

Scissors and paper cutter
Glue (if using printer paper)
Sandwich baggies or
envelopes

# HOW TO ASSEMBLE: 

1. Print the first three pages of each activity on sticker paper or printer paper.
2. Print the accompanying game pieces on cardstock.
3. Cut out the labels and game mats on the lines. Do NOT cut out the images on the game mats; just cut around the bold rectangle (as shown in the bottom photo).
4. Stick or glue the cover label and title label onto the front of the file folder (as shown in the top photo).
5. Stick or glue the directions label onto the back of the file folder.
6. Stick or glue the game mats into the inside of the file folder (as shown).

7. Cut out and laminate the game pieces and place them in a baggie or envelope.
8. I use sticker paper for the labels and game mats.
9. Laminate the file folders and pieces so they'Il last longer!
10. For some of the games, try using sticky loop-andhook dots (like Velcro ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ ) on the pieces and mats.
